



## 2017 FIA International License Information

Thank you for contacting WKA to obtain your FIA International License. New for 2017, ACCUS, (the ASN for the USA), has slightly altered the procedures to obtain an FIA International License, for both Driver and Entrant. As an ACCUS Member Club, SCCA will be licensing Karters for 2017.

To obtain the license applications and other requirements, please visit the SCCA Pro website, [www.SCCAProRacing.com](http://www.SCCAProRacing.com) and click on Downloads from the Website Menu. To obtain the FIA International License, applicants will need to submit to SCCA:

- FIA Karting License Application
- Completed and Signed Physical Exam Form
- SCCA Pro Application
- Adult or Minor Waiver, depending on age
- Your Racing Resume, past 24-months
- One Passport-size photo of the applicant

You will notice, there is a contact at the bottom of the SCCAProRacing.com Downloads page should you have any specific questions, or need further assistance with SCCA's procedures/forms.

If you are participating in a Karting Event outside of the USA, it is highly recommended that you ensure the requirements the promoter places on the event. It may or may not require more than an FIA International License. There are also new CIK Age Requirements for 2017 that may affect your qualification for an FIA International License as well.

Should the event you are participating in indicates that you only need a USA National Karting License, or "a letter" to participate, or you experience an off-hour emergency, you can remain in contact with the WKA, Ph. 704-455-1606 for assistance.
